**Not Market Ready:** Good or lower quality grade \$ 2.00  
with 12<sup>th</sup> rib back fat range <.08 or >.22; under finished goats grading USDA good or lower, below average conformation or cutability.

- 3 Exhibitor must own and care for pet goat at least 60 days prior to the fair. Animals do not have to be owned by the exhibitor, but must be in the care of the exhibitor. Goat cannot be older than 4 months of the first day of fair.
- 4 Animals are not eligible for sale at the Junior Livestock Auction.
- 5 Judging based on overall appearance of the animal, soundness, health, ability of exhibitor to control animal, exhibitor's knowledge of feeding and other facts of the animal.
