I further understand that failure to provide complete and accurate information of my exhibitor eligibility information AND each and every entry by the designated date, shall result in the disqualification of each entry missing all or part of the information stated above. I understand that by participating in the fair my photograph may be taken and my name, city of residence, and/or club organization may be released. My signature on this form authorizes the Fair Association to use said photographs, name, City of residence, and/or club/organization for promotional and public releases.

Exhibitor Code of Practice for participation in The Redwood Acres Fair Junior Livestock Competitions. As an animal exhibitor in The Redwood Acres Fair Livestock Competition Program, I realize that I am responsible for; 1) the proper care and humane treatment of my animal(s); 2) the production of wholesome food if my exhibit animal(s) are designated for market; and 3) the development of sound moral character in myself. I understand and agree that when I, my parents/legal guardian, supervisor/instructor/leader or any other adult or minor connected with my project(s) or animal(s) break the rules, I agree to live by the final decision of Fair Management regarding disqualification of myself and/or my animal(s), loss of premium awards, loss of future eligibility, and forfeiture of any award(s).

As an animal exhibitor in The Redwood Acres Fair Junior Livestock Program: I understand that by entering an animal in a market class, that the Sale of Excellence is a Terminal Sale. I believe my participation should demonstrate my own ability, knowledge and skill as a feeder and fitter of my show animal(s). I understand the need to be responsible for developing the skills necessary to take my animal(s) from the farm to the showing. I will assist other juniors, if asked, or request assistance from other juniors exhibiting in the Junior Show. I will follow the competition rules, and will not use abusive, questionable or unethical techniques in the feeding, caring and showing of my animal(s). I will not resort to fraudulent, illegal or deceptive practices when fitting and preparing the animal for show. I also will not allow my parents, supervisor/leader or any other adult or minor to employ such practices to my animal(s). I have read and understand the rules and regulations found in the Livestock Guidebook and I have asked my parents and the supervisor/leader of my project to not break the rules or make exception on my behalf. I want my animal project to be an example of how to accept what life has to offer, good or bad, and how to live with the outcome. I realize that I am responsible for the proper care and humane treatment of my animal(s); the production of wholesome food if my exhibit animal is designated for market; and the development of sound moral character in myself. I understand and agree that when I, my parents, my supervisor or leader or any other adult or minor connected with my project or animal(s) break the rule, I agree to live by the final decision of the Fair Management regarding disqualification of myself and/or my animal(s), loss of premium awards and my loss of future eligibility, and forfeiture of any award(s).

Parents/guardians shall refrain from: a) bringing or using any weapons or illegal substances onto the Fairgrounds, b) irresponsible alcohol use (public intoxication), c) smoking or vaping outside of designated areas, d) interfering with the judging process, e) inappropriate language, and f) emotional (intentional infliction of distress, anguish or intimidation through non-physical acts. Mental and emotional abuse can also include coercion, harassment or isolation of an individual) or physical (violent behavior by one person towards another that results in substantial bodily injury. Physical abuse may include but is not limited to: slapping, hitting, kicking, biting, choking, smothering, shoving, dragging, throwing, punching, shaking, burning, cutting or the use of corporal punishment) abuse towards exhibitors, judges, staff, and other fair participants. Sale of Excellence and authorize the 9th District Agricultural Association (9th DAA) and the Junior Livestock Sale Committee to act as the agent for selling my animal, I understand that all auction sales are final and this is a terminal sale meaning, that an animal in the sale will not be sold as a live pick-up. All large animals will be processed for human consumption at a processing plant chosen by the 9th DAA.

Sales Agreement:

1. I understand that when my project is sold there will be charges deducted from my check including a 10% commission fee. An additional processing fee(s), and species fees/assessments as mandated by the federal check off programs may be deducted.
2. I understand that the Redwood Acres Fair Sale of Excellence is a terminal sale, for all market species. This means there is no live animal pick-up on any animal in the sale, there is only custom processing.
Definitions: **Custom:** the animal is processed and returned to a cut and wrap facility where the buyer will pay to have it cut and wrapped and then pick up the meat. (The buyer is responsible for additional fees for this service)
3. I understand that livestock sold in this auction has been entered in the appropriate class and exhibited by the owner and graded by a judge determining the animal to be market ready.
4. Beef, Sheep, Swine & Goat Weigh-in was held on Tuesday, June 16, 2026, on the Redwood Acres Fairgrounds and animals are sold on the basis of those weights. Rabbits and Poultry are sold by the lot not the pound.
5. I understand that the top payment weight is 1,400 lbs. for steers; 120 lbs. for goats; 300 lbs. for swine and 150 lbs. for lambs. Any weight over those specified will not be paid to the owner.
6. Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder without reserve. All sales are final at the discretion of the auctioneer. The auctioneer will settle any dispute concerning bids by declaring all bids off and reselling the animal in question.

7. I understand that if I fail to sell and submit a Sale Luncheon Ticket by the deadline, fail to attend the Mandatory Exhibitor Meeting on Friday, or fail to submit a Buyer Thank You Note by the deadline that I will be fined \$100.00 per occurrence.
8. I understand that I am under no obligation to sell my animal at the Redwood Acres Fair Sale of Excellence but realize that should I have a champion or reserve champion animal they must be sold. If I should decline to sell my animal after 7:00 PM on Thursday, June 18, 2026, I will forfeit the ability to participate in the 2027 Redwood Acres Fair. In all cases the decision to sell or not must be made prior to the sale of the animal on the auction block.
9. I understand that I must care for and feed my animals for the duration of the Redwood Acres Fair.
10. I further understand that by entering my animal in the Redwood Acres Fair I acknowledge that I have read, understand, and agreed to abide by the rules as stated in the 2026 Livestock Guidebook.

Drug Statement:

1. I have completed and submitted my Declaration of Medication Form to the fair.
2. I further understand that I am responsible for any fees and/or fines should the carcass be rejected at the packing plant. Seller will not receive payment for a rejected carcass.

Indemnity:

The undersigned agrees to indemnify and hold harmless, the State of California, the California Fair Services Authority, the 9th District Agricultural Association (also known as the Redwood Acres Fair), the Junior Livestock Sale Committee, their directors, officers, agents, employees, volunteers and successors from any and all loses, claims, actions or proceedings of any kinds, including reimbursement for all legal costs and attorney fees incurred by the indemnified parties or any of them, for the defense of any such actions which may hereinafter occur.
