



### **What is the Junior Fair Board?**

The Redwood Acres Junior Fair Board is composed of high school aged youth members (youth finishing their 8<sup>th</sup> grade year are eligible to join) from the community, who act to represent, promote, and support the Redwood Acres Fair. The Junior Fair Board hosts the Welcome Back BBQ the first evening exhibitors are at the fair along with the Dessert Auction (our biggest fundraiser) that same evening. They also have events during the fair such as the Barnyard Olympics and work with the Livestock Auction Committee on the Sale of Excellence and Buyers BBQ at the conclusion of the fair. One of the Junior Fair Board fundraisers is creating and selling a basket of Humboldt Made items that is auctioned off at the start of the Sale of Excellence. Once selected to be on the Junior Fair Board, members serve a 2 year term, but will be required to submit a re-application in year two. Members are welcome to re-apply after serving a 2 year term.

### **Requirements:**

- You must currently be entered or enrolled in a Humboldt, Del Norte or Trinity County high school
- You must reside in Humboldt, Del Norte or Trinity County
- You must be an enrolled member in good standing with a 4-H Club, FFA Chapter, or the Grange in Humboldt, Del Norte or Trinity County, or have an active interest in supporting our district fairgrounds by assisting with community minded events.
- You must have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- You must be willing to make the activities of the Junior Fair Board a top priority up to and during the Redwood Acres Fair
- You must be willing to help with three or more events at the fairgrounds throughout the year.
- Members of the Redwood Acres Junior Fair Board must re-apply to the board every two years.
- Applicants must submit an application and 2 letters of recommendation from adults not related to them (i.e. teacher, leader, advisor, or community members).
